The highlight of the evening is the *Kechak* dance – where 30 male dancers form a circle chanting away in synchronization as a priest tosses holy water. A storyteller narrates excerpts from the Ramayana in tandem with the movements. Price: S\$35++ adult/S\$18++ child. Program starts at 8 pm with a 45-minute Kechak dance followed by dinner with traditional dance and music as entertainment. Guests will then be given 50% discount coupons to party afterwards at Silk.
